

## Windows XP Registry Time Format

REGISTRY KEY	DATA FORMAT	AM/PM TIME	24 HOUR TIME
iTime	sZ	0	1
iTLZero	sZ	0	1
sTimeFormat	sZ	h:mm:ss tt	HH:mm:ss

### Using ".reg" files to change the time format

1. Create a new plain text file using a plain text editor like Windows Notepad.
2. Copy and paste all the lines from the appropriate time settings below into this new plain text file.

### AM/PM Time Format (Windows Default)

```
Windows Registry Editor Version 5.00

[HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Control Panel\International]
"iTime"="0"
"iTLZero"="0"
"sTimeFormat"="h:mm:ss tt"

[HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Control Panel\International\Geo]
"Nation"="244"
```

### 24 Hour Time Format

```
Windows Registry Editor Version 5.00

[HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Control Panel\International]
"iTime"="1"
"iTLZero"="1"
"sTimeFormat"="HH:mm:ss"

[HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Control Panel\International\Geo]
"Nation"="244"
```

3. Save this file as "RegistryTimeFormat.reg" and close the plain text editor.
4. Doubleclick this saved ".reg" file and confirm to apply the settings to the Windows Registry.
5. Log off and on again, or reboot if necessary to apply these settings (\*\* except Windows XP Embedded).

### \*\* Windows XP Embedded

Follow the "Windows XP Embedded Change and Commit Procedure" to store the new registry settings permanently in CompactFLASH to prevent them from being lost on powerdown. Contact EdgeTech to obtain a copy of this procedure.
